
Hot KnifeTM INSTRUCTIONS

Warning!

Be aware that this is a limited use tool.

- 1.To avoid overheating and damaging the tool, depress the trigger for 15 seconds, then release the trigger for 15 seconds. Continue this cycle for a maximum of 5 minutes. Then let the tool rest for 2½ minutes. Using the tool longer than 5 minutes will cause heat damage and is not covered by the warranty.
- 2.Do not use a screwdriver to tighten the blade screws. Finger Tighten only!



- 7. Avoid cutting anything that could emit toxic gas such as Urethane or PVC.
- 8. Limit extension cords to 100 feet or less. 12/3 gauge cord is recommended when extension cords are needed.
- 9. Use caution when removing a hot blade from the tool.
- 10. This appliance has a polarized plug. One blade is wider that the other. To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit in a polarized out let only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, turn the plug over and reinsert. If th still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician, Do not modify the plug in any way.
